This two-session workshop is inspired by the mural, Affordable Housing for Trans Elders, by Edie Fake, on view at the Berkeley Art Museum and Pacific Film Archive (BAMPFA) this spring. Drawing on vernacular building styles, gay and trans flag designs, and decorative patterning, Fake's mural envisions and celebrates the potential of queer space while underlining an urgent social need. The artist will join us for the May 11 session.

- Writers of all genres and experience levels, ages 14-18, are welcome.
- Please plan to attend both sessions.
- Themes will be evoked and prompts given, but writers are always encouraged to trust their own creativity and write however they are inspired.
- Sign up before March 30th and attend both sessions to receive a FREE FILM PASS to any BAMPFA film screening.
